"Happy Times" is the <u>extended hours mode for preschool</u> that we offer with an additional cost.

This program consists in giving our students the possibility of staying in the campus after school's regular schedule.

We offer 2 Schedules:

Nursery, Pre-Kinder, and Kinder

Until **2:30pm**, with a monthly cost of **c60.000** colones (includes lunch service). The cost of the service for a specific day is **c5.000**. colones per day.

Nursery, Pre-Kinder, Kinder:

Until **5:00pm**, with a monthly cost of **c85.000 colones** (includes lunch service, and each student must bring a snack for the afternoon) The cost of the service for a specific day is **c8.000 colones per day.** (**c8.000 colones if the student stays from 12:00 md to 5:00p.m.**)

> Prep:

Until 5:00p.m., with the monthly cost of **c50.000 colones.** The cost for a specific day would be **c3.000 colones.**

After School for Elementary

"After School" is the <u>extended primary school schedule</u> that the Institution offers with an additional cost of **c50.000 colones per month**. The After-School option consists on offering our students from levels Prep to 6th Grade the option to stay at the school until 5:00 pm (the regular departure time is 2:30 pm).

During this time, they will play, have a snack, and study for their exams and quizzes accompanied by a teacher that will look after them. The students must bring their own snack for the afternoon.

If you need the service for only one day, the cost would be **c3.000 colones**.

Seventh, Eighth, and Ninth:
